‘Reconciliation – The Love of Christ Compels Us’ (2 Corinthians 5.14–20)

Near to the beginning of the year in which we remember the start of the Reformation, with Martin Luther’s publication of his 95 Theses, we celebrate the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity. In truth, the church had seeds of division sown within it from the start, as a cursory reading of Acts and the Pauline letters demonstrates. Division continues to the present day. So often we are set against each other by the minutiae of theological dispute, sometimes relating to issues long since forgotten.

Perhaps this is a time to focus less on belief and more on praxis. A lead has been given by Pope Francis in his practical application of the gospel to his actions and lifestyle. I am reminded of the words of John Wesley in a sermon in which he puts love at the centre, and says to those with widely differing opinions, ‘if your heart is with my heart [in relation to love of God and love of neighbour], then give me your hand’. In a world climate where division is ever evident, through our actions we in the churches could provide a living parable of human unity. ‘What shall our greeting be, sign of our unity ... give me your hand, my friend’ (Fred Pratt Green)
