For those celebrating Peter and Paul, Apostles, see pages 16 and 17. During Ordinary Time (the green season) there are two options for the Old Testament reading and Psalm in the Common Worship Lectionary and the Revised Common Lectionary. The first set provides a (semi) 'continuous' reading of sections of the Old Testament. The second option provides an Old Testament reading and Psalm which are 'related' to the Gospel reading. The Gospel and the reading from an epistle are the same for each option. The same option should be chosen for each week.
